SANITARY SEWER INVESTIGATIONS

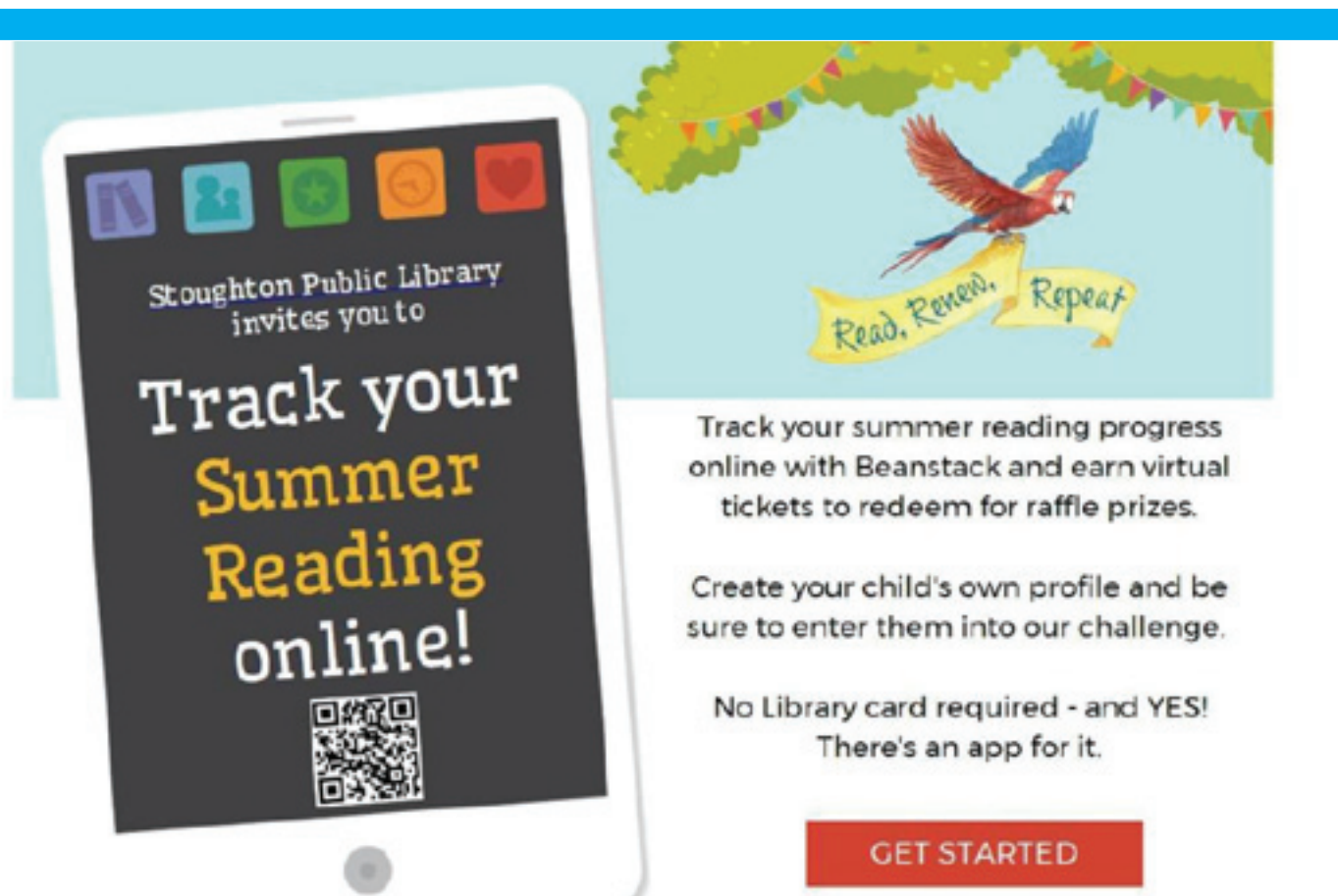
On behalf of the Town of Stoughton, the Town's wastewater consultants, Weston & Sampson, will be conducting investigations of the sanitary sewer system throughout Town between June and August 2024. Weston & Sampson and its subcontractor, National Water Main Cleaning Company, may need to access your property to conduct the investigations in sanitary sewer easements operated and maintained by the Town.

These investigations are being conducted as part of Stoughton's 2024 Infiltration Investigation Project. The purpose of the investigations is to locate sources of groundwater entering the sanitary sewer. By removing this extra flow, Stoughton will reduce the amount of wastewater it sends to the Massachusetts Water Resources Authority (MWRA) sewer interceptors.

The regular work hours will generally be Monday through Friday, 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM, with some exceptions for after hours.

We apologize for any inconvenience you may experience during this work and appreciate your continued cooperation while we strive to improve our sanitary sewer system.

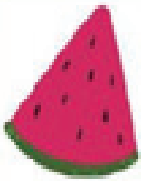
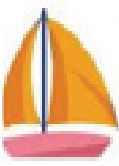

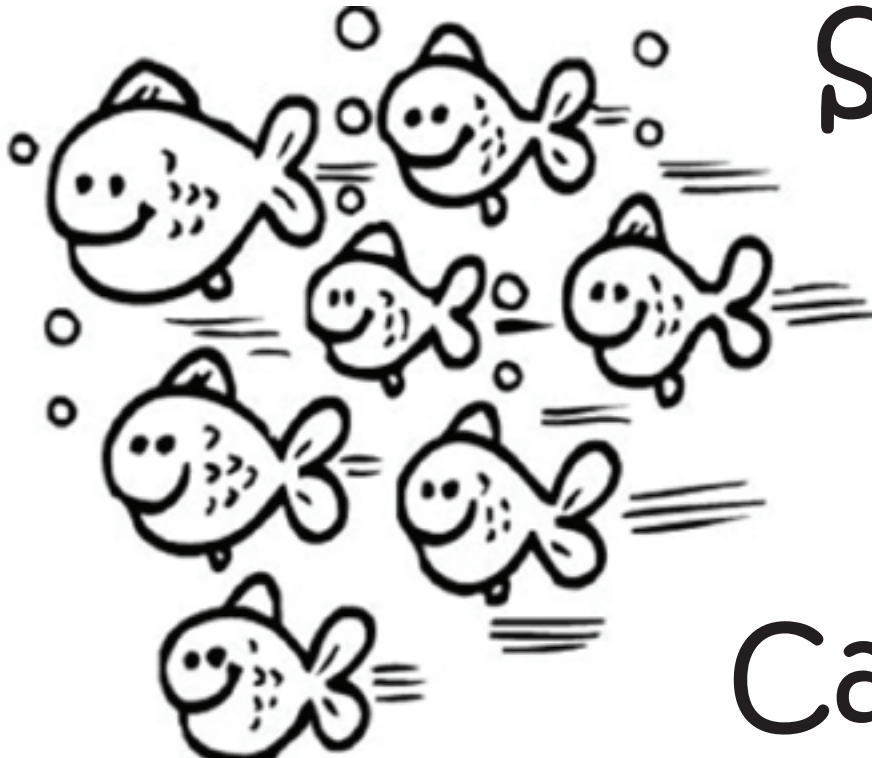
