Rate sheet Effective October 2023

A. Quarterly Rubbish Collection Fee

Single-family home \$90 per quarter
Two-family home \$225 per quarter
Three-family home \$360 per quarter

- Related family members who live in multi-Unit dwellings will be charged the single family price per unit

B. Recycling collections are twice monthly and the service is included in the quarterly rubbish fee.

C. Senior discount – 50% off quarterly fee.

D. Senior Eligibility – 65 years of Age.

E. Owner occupied homes held in Trust are eligible to receive the Senior discount.

F. The Fee schedule for bulk materials is shown in this brochure.

Town of Stoughton Solid Waste Program

All rubbish must be packaged in a bag of your choice. Residents are encouraged to place their bags in a barrel.

The DPW will NO LONGER accept loose trash.

Bulky and Metal Items must be scheduled for pick up on Mondays. Scheduling can be done online on the town website <https://www.stoughton.org/188/Trash-Recycling-Schedules-Information>

You can also download the Recycle Coach app to your phone. This app will give you access to your trash/recycle schedules as well as ability to schedule pickups.

In order to preserve the beauty of our Town and prevent incidents of illegal dumping, an inspector will travel around Town daily to provide guidance and ensure compliance with the Town's Solid Waste program. The inspector will work closely with the Stoughton Police Department to investigate incidents of illegal dumping.

Household Rubbish

• Rubbish may be placed curbside once a week in front of residential addresses with three or fewer family units. Any rubbish not contained within bags will not be picked up by the Public Works Department.

• Rubbish **MUST** be placed at curbside by 7:00 a.m. on the scheduled collection day but not before 7:00 p.m. the prior day.

Items Not Acceptable For Curbside Pickup

Home construction, repair or demolition materials, sheetrock, shingles, lumber, fences, carpeting and rugs, Etc.
Logs, Stumps, Brush And Branches
Rocks, Dirt, Concrete, Asphalt, Sand, Gravel, Etc.
Pallets And Skids
Hot Coals / Embers
Tires
Motor oil (may be disposed of anywhere it can be purchased)
Porcelain Materials (Toilets, Sinks, Tubs)
50 or 55-Gallon Drums
Car Parts
Furniture
Leaves

No loose trash.



Recyclables Collection

We are now single streaming; you no longer need to separate your recyclables.

Curbside recycling collection is provided twice per month. All recyclables must be placed in a container labeled "Recyclables" Stickers are provided at DPW. Recycling barrels **MUST** be 32 gallons or smaller.



Cardboard goes with recycling only

Don't put the following in your recycle bins

Trash, plastic bags, light bulbs, string lights, clothes, yard waste, styrofoam or packing peanuts, plastic plant pots, wax cartons, anything with food waste in it.



Bulky Metal Objects for Recycling

- Items for pick up must be 90% metal
- Pick-up and transportation fee for the following items will be \$30.00 each.
- Most common bulk recyclable items to be picked up:

Scrap Metal	Propane Tanks
Appliances	Bikes
Grills	Small Metal Boats
Freezers	Stoves
Refrigerators	Washing Machines
Lawn Mowers	Dryers
Metal Furniture	Dishwashers
Air Conditioners	Cast Iron Tub

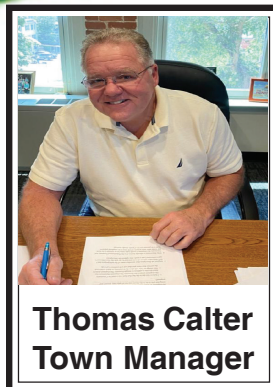
