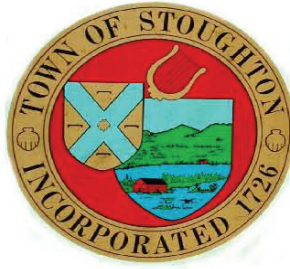

Join instructors Laurice and Allene to create a one of a kind watercolor painting! All materials are included in the fee for this two part workshop.

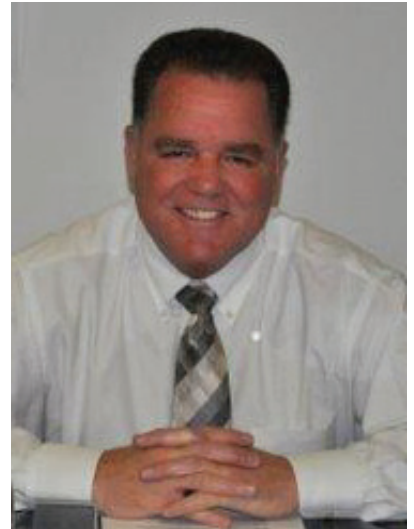
The first class will introduce participants to watercolor paper types, brushes, paints and techniques. Class two, students will learn to create a floral painting using the techniques they have learned.
