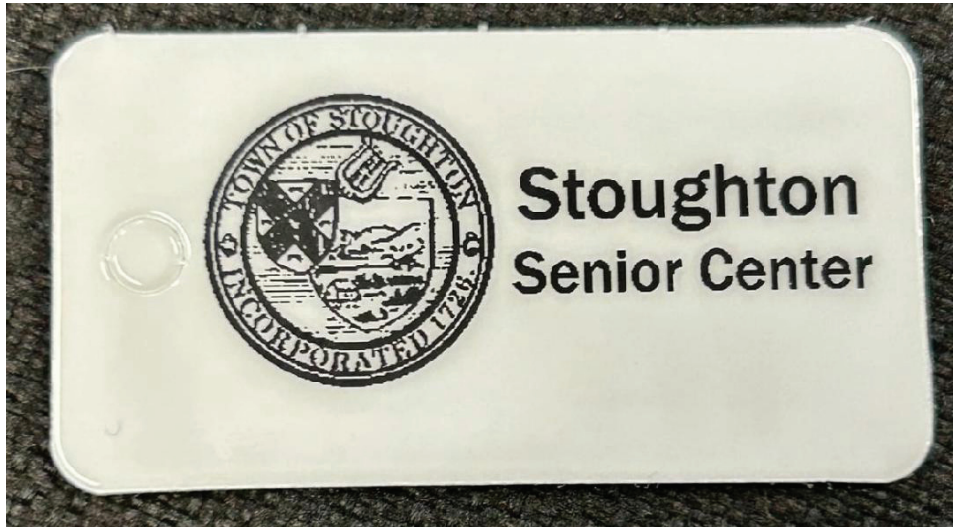
Posture and Balance with Steve Avellino \$42 for Six-week program Friday 9AM

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The Stoughton COA receives grant funding based on how many seniors over 60 participate at the senior center.

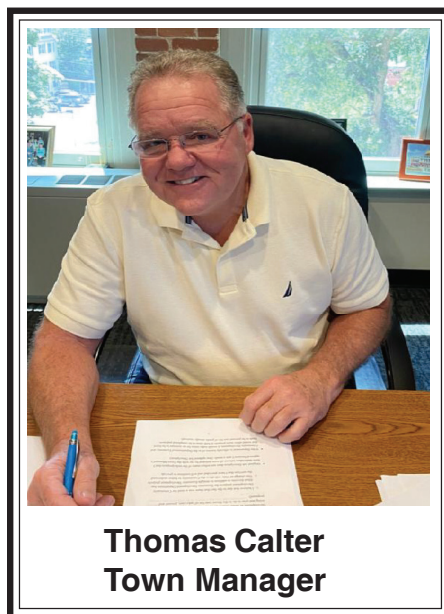
It will keep track of everything you do while you are here.
