Complete Snow Plowing Operation responses will be accepted at the Town Hall Procurement Department, 3rd floor 10 Pearl Street before November 9, 2023.

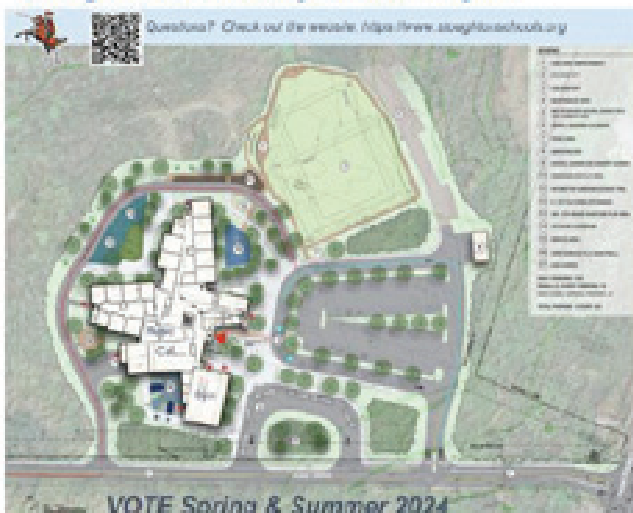
The number of contracted pieces of equipment will be determined by the DPW Superintendent based on the needs to supplement the Town's equipment

Existing South Elementary School

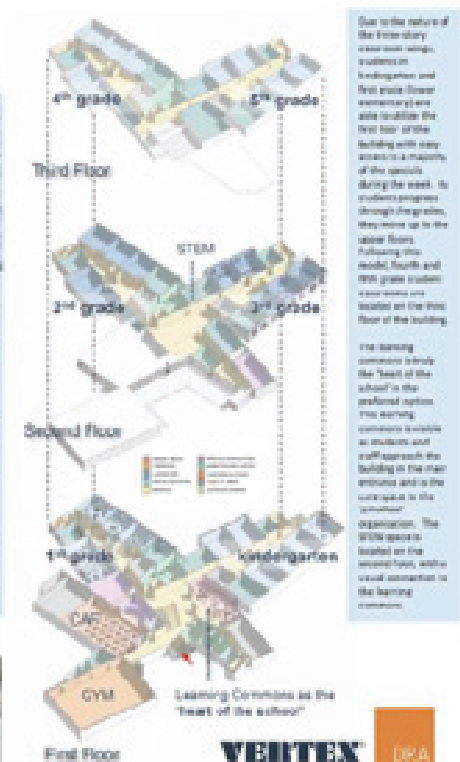
This compact three-story building arranges the classroom neighborhood program in a powerful configuration along three common thoroughfares from the end of learning corridors to the end of learning corridors. The fourth leg of the plan includes the entrance and symphony with dedicated community entrance.

The entire program is grade-level classroom neighborhood in each wing. Each classroom neighborhood includes general classrooms, a substantially separate special education class, resource rooms, learning centers, and a dedicated learning space. For each wing, there are three general classrooms or grade-level class. There are five general classrooms.

Building spaces are designed for access for each of the classroom neighborhood. Multiple types of outdoor learning spaces are available for educational purposes, including a nature play area north of the building.

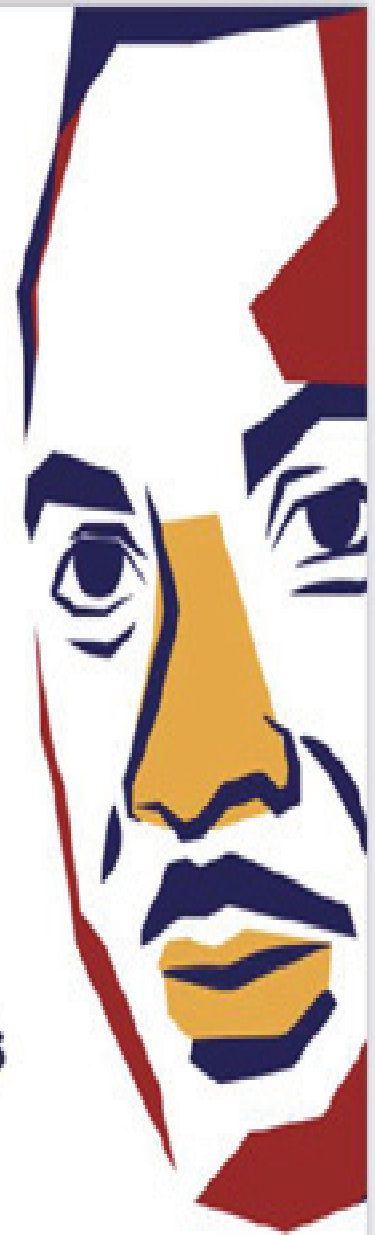

Two keyboards for individuals who have difficulty seeing the keys on a typical keyboard have been donated by the Disabilities Commission to the Stoughton library. The keys are back lit and have a larger print than a standard keyboard. Ask the librarians to find the location of the keyboards.



A "Free Wheel" wheelchair adapter has been donated by the Disabilities Commission to the Stoughton Recreation Department. This additional wheel attaches to the front of a manual wheelchair, making it more stable on uneven surfaces. It can be borrowed by individuals wanting to explore the Story Book trail, Glen Echo park or other trails around town.
