

Recycling should be separated as follows:

What to recycle:

- Cardboard (no pizza boxes)
- Paperboard (cereal & tissue boxes, paper towel rolls)
- Magazine & newspaper (glossy paper is OK)
- Phones books & junk mail (no CD's or plastic wrap)
- Soft cover books
- All office paper (no blueprints)

Paper:

- Must be loose in a container provided by the Public Works Dept. or labeled with Recycle Stickers

Cardboard:

- Flatten, cut to 2ft x 2ft and secure under or between
- Flatten, fold & stuff in your paper recycling bin

Glass, Metal & Plastic Containers:

Must be Loose and No Plastic Bags

What to recycle:

- Aluminum (pie plates, trays & foil)
- Glass containers (any color)
- Metal Cans (tin, steel & aluminum)
- Stiff plastic containers (#1-5 & #7, no plastic bags or Styrofoam)

What to Bring to the Recycle

Center on Sat 8-4 ONLY

- Leaves and Grass Clippings will be emptied into a compost pile – doesn't need lawn bags
- Large Pieces of cardboard must be flattened

Non Acceptable Materials

- Construction Materials
- Porcelain

DISPOSAL OF HOUSEHOLD TRASH

CURBSIDE COLLECTION:

1. Rubbish Collection is provided weekly and recycling is twice a month. Changes in schedule (holidays, etc.) will be posted on the Town website and on Public Works Facebook Page.
2. If a holiday falls on your collection day, it will be picked up on the next working day. Mon-Fri
3. Holidays are as follows: New Year's Day, M.L. King Day, Washington's Birthday, Patriots Day, Memorial Day, Juneteenth, Independence Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.
4. All rubbish must be curbside by 7:00 a.m. on your collection day. ****Please be courteous not to leave your trash & recycling out more than 24 hrs.***
5. Rubbish which is not at curbside when the truck reaches that location **will not** be collected later.
6. Rugs/carpet must be cut into widths of no more than 4' and tied into rolls of no more than 12" in diameter for collection at curbside. Same with lumber/wood, nails & screws must be removed.
7. **No barrel over 32 gallon size will be emptied. No loose trash.**
8. Bags & boxes torn, broken, or water-soaked due to weather, will be the responsibility of the homeowner. Same with plastic containers that are broken or damaged.
9. Mattresses: Twin & full w/box spring; queen & king 1 piece per week.
10. Metals and appliances must be called in to the Public Works Dept. to schedule an appointment to be picked up, or can be brought to 100 Page St from 8-4:00 pm **Saturday's ONLY.**
11. **TVs and computer monitors w/color tubes must be called in to the Public Works Dept. to schedule an appointment to be picked up. Flat screens/ Projection are regular trash**
12. Paint- Must be 100% dry and then regular trash – Do not put it in bags
13. Construction debris will not be picked up.
